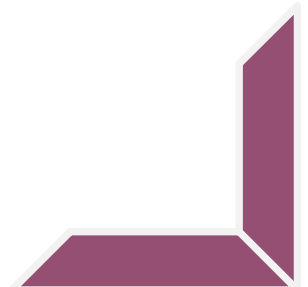


WHO WE ARE AND WHERE WE OPERATE?

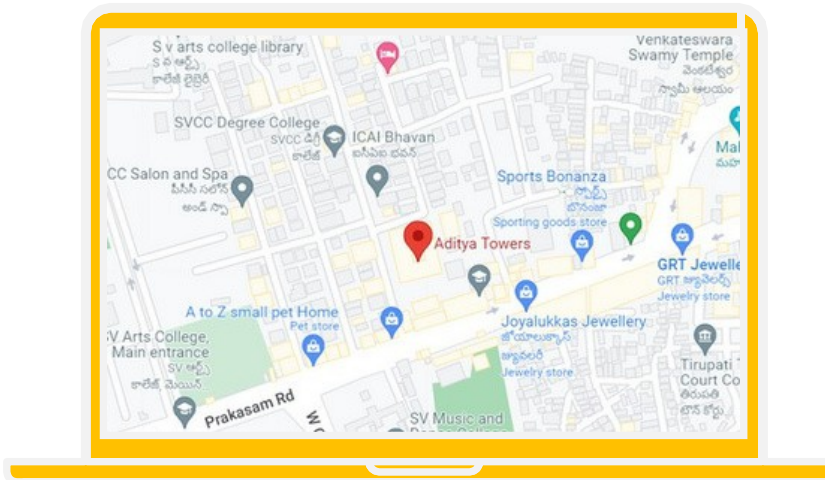

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

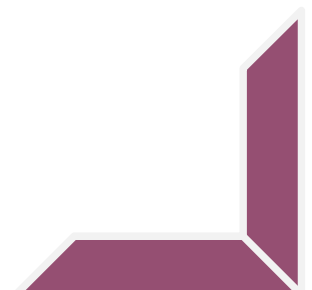

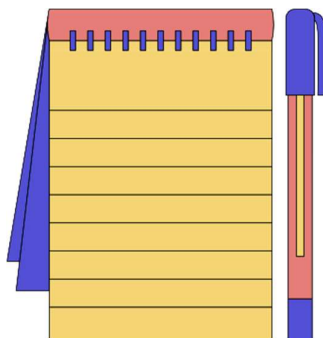


OUR MISSION, VISION & OBJECTIVE

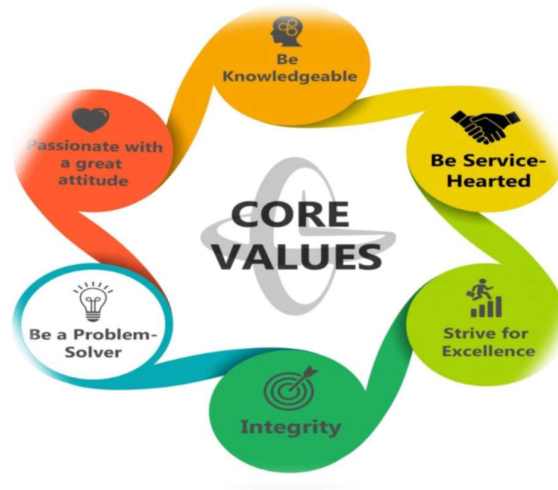

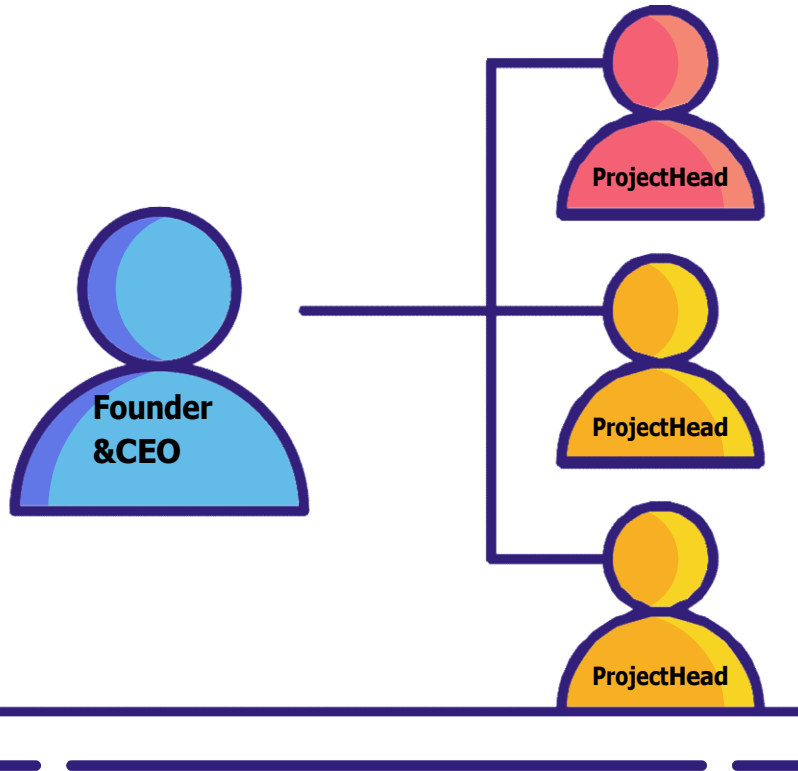

1. During the Covid 19 Pandemic situation we supported to 200 vulnerable families in Chittoor and surrounding district of Andhra Pradesh with Dry ration kits distribution program.
2. Organized skill training work shops for women.
3. Organized training work shops for farmers.
4. Organized legal awareness work shops for women & farmers.
5. Organized online Health awareness work shop conducted (HIV/AIDS, Covid Support etc.)
6. Conducted Youth Development programs (Personality development program, Skill development Program.)
7. Organized Capacity Building program for the Youth Mandal's, Grassr out NGO's and Women Self Help Group.
8. Conducted Social and Economic Survey.
9. Educate people about nature conservation and plantation.

OUR PROGRAMME

Training in Tailoring

Program Summary: The rural poor women living below poverty line were provided tailoring training for self-employment. The training was provided for 6 months. The training was given in tailoring basic skills, garments making in child dresses. The trained trainees were given training certificates after completion of the training course. The rural poor women living below poverty line were provided tailoring training for self-employment. The training was provided for 6 months. The training was given in tailoring basic skills, garments making in child dresses. The trained trainees were given training certificates after completion of the training course.

Beautician Training

Program Summary: The rural poor women living below poverty line were provided beautician training for self-employment. The training was provided for 3 months. The training was given in facial, hairstyles, mehndi, bridegroom and child birthday makeups, nail polish and painting. The trained trainees were given training certificates after completion of the training course.

Training Hand Embroidery

Program Summary: The rural poor women living below poverty line were provided training in hand embroidery for self-employment. The training was provided for 3 months. The training was given in tools and kits of operation, designs and design material like beads, mirrors, etc. The training certificates were provided after completion of the training.

Work shops on single woman issue:

Program Summary: The work shop was conducted on single women issues. The students, women activists, NGOs and women were involved to discuss the themes. The participants discussed the issues like sexual abuse, discriminations, rent house problems, harassment at work place and stigma in the society.

OUR PROGRAMME

Work shops on NRI Marriages Issue:

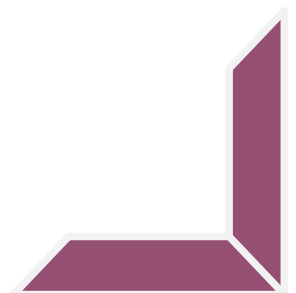
Program Summary: The workshop was conducted on the NRI marriage issues. The students, women activists, NGOS and women were involved to discuss the themes. The participants discussed the issues like deceits of bridegroom for dowry, harassment for additional dowry, extra marital affairs of the NRI and abuse of NRI wife, the weakness of law related to these crimes in the country and desert of NRI wife. The precautions in NRI marriages were discussed.

Work shops on cyber crimes against woman:

Program Summary: The workshop was conducted on the theme of the cyber-crimes against women in the internet world. The students, women activists, NGOS and women were involved to discuss the themes. The sub themes like online harassment, pornography, scooping and sexual abuse through Facebook were discussed. The participants shared their experience and advise the precautions to prevent them. In this context the IT Act, relevant sections for punishment and complaints filing and complaints online line filing were discussed.

Farmers Training on Bio-Fertilizers:

Program Summary: The small and marginal farmers were provided demonstration cum trainings on biofertilizers. The training was given on Bacterial Biofertilizers: Such as Rhizobium, Azospirillum, Azotobacter, Phosphobacteria; Fungal Bio fertilizers such as Mycorrhiza Algal Biofertilizers: such as Blue Green Algae (BGA) and Akola, Actinimycetes Bio fertilizers: such as Frankie. The Bio fertilizers applications for the crops were explained to the farmers.



OUR PROGRAMME

Farmers training in crop pattern:

Program Summary: The trainings were conducted to small and marginal farmers on crop pattern for sustainable yield and income by low input cost. The farmers were trained in mixed crops, inter crops, buffer crop~ and pest management crops. The demonstration was arranged for practical learning.

Farmers Training in Composting:

Program Summary: The compost making trainings were provided to small and marginal farmers to promote organic farming in their crop lands and minimize the input cost. The trainings were conducted on heap, pit, NADEP and vermi composting methods. The demonstrations were conducted during trainings.

Training in live stock management:

Program Summary: The rural poor communities rely on livestock rearing for additional income. The women are associated in this work. So training was provided to rural poor women of below poverty line in order to impart skills for high yields and income. The training was given on cattle housing, breed selection, scientific feeding, insemination, calf rearing, low-cost feed making with local available feed material and growing fodder grass and plants.

Awareness on coronavirus:

Program Summary: The principle of coronavirus prevention was explained to the participants. The physical distancing, sanitization, mask wearing, were given training certificates after completion of the training course, testing and treatment for infected persons and precaution for home quarantine



OUR PROGRAMME

Health awareness camp:

Program Summary: The awareness was created to women on health and sanitation. The awareness was created on health aspects such as chronic disease and precautions, water borne diseases and prevention, nutrition diet and immunity, personal, domestic and environmental hygiene, waste management, childcare and nutrition, pregnancy care and ICDS service for children and pregnant women.

Awareness on climate change:

Program Summary: The global warming is invisible threat to the existence of earth and the living beings on the earth. The earth is being warmed up and resulted climate change. This by industries, waste disposal and agriculture waste burning and decrease of tree population So the awareness was created on fuel efficient burning stoves, domestic and farm waste management, growing trees to reduce the carbon dioxide emission into atmosphere. The awareness helps to initiate local action by understanding the effects of climate change like heat waves, crop failure, drought, species extinction and skin diseases.

Awareness on global warming:

Program Summary: The climate change is a global issue to act local communities to mitigate the problem. The global warming by excess accumulation of Green House gases in the atmosphere is the reason for climate change. The harbingers and foot prints of global warming were explained to the students. The science of global warming was taught to the student.

Awareness on biodiversity:

Program Summary: The biodiversity camps were organized to the students on holidays. The students were taken to rich biodiversity hotspot for exposure. The students firstly taught on the biodiversity, animal and plant kingdoms and species. They were directed to roam in the area to identify the species wise biodiversity and note down the names or name known to bring the part of the species for name identification by local people. The biodiversity exposure camps were organized to participants to understand the biodiversity existing in the area.

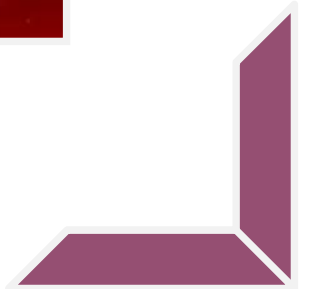

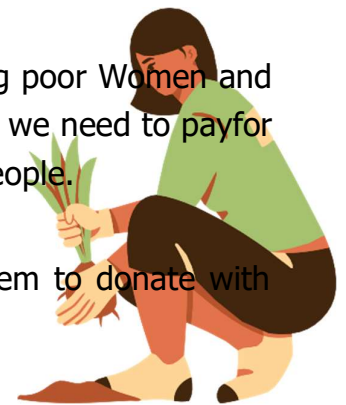
REQUIREMENTS OF OUR NGO
